BDA Hamburg Architecture Prize 2018

Public Architecture Prize 2018

An essential role of the BDA (Federation of German Architects, Branch Hamburg) is to enhance and encourage the quality of planning and construction in the sense of responsibility towards society and the environment.

The BDA Hamburg Architecture Prize is given out with the goal of singling out exemplary building construction in the metropolitan area of the Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg.

This award should contribute to enhancing and encouraging the public's awareness of quality in planning and construction, and to setting benchmarks in quality for contemporary architecture.

Here it is not just the achievement of the architects which is celebrated, but also the responsibility of the construction partners.

The BDA Hamburg Architecture Prize is usually awarded every two years.

Based on the BDA Hamburg Architecture Prize, the BDA Hamburg and the daily newspaper Hamburger Abendblatt also award the Public Architecture Prize. The readers of the Hamburger Abendblatt will vote an additional winner based on the juries shortlist.

Eligibility and projects

- Architects and their construction partners, if necessary, are eligible.
- The buildings presented must be situated in the metropolitan area of Hamburg and have been completed after 1st January 2016.
- Each architect, or rather, each partnership, should present no more than three projects, if possible. Consortiums are considered as one party.
- Projects which have taken part in earlier awards relating to the BDA Hamburg Architecture Prize are not eligible for participation.
- The BDA Hamburg Architecture Prize can be awarded to a structure, a group of buildings or an urban development project.
- Nominations or information regarding buildings worthy of the prize shall also be accepted from third parties (e.g. building and planning administrations, professors of architecture and planning at universities, etc.). BDA Hamburg shall then request the participation in the procedure of the nominated architect.
- BDA Hamburg can also make its own nominations and requests for documentation.
- A nominal fee shall be charged for the participation in the procedure, as well as in the official presentation and in the catalogue.

Documentation to be submitted

- A maximum of 10 illustrations showing the description of the structure are permitted to be submitted for pre-consideration by the jury. They are to be submitted in digital form on CD or DVD in jpg format at a resolution of 72 dpi and an image size of a maximum of DIN A 4 or via download to info@bda-hamburg.de. PowerPoint or other presentations are not permitted.
- The submitted illustrations are to be numbered 1 to 10 in the order in which they are to be presented. A list of them with a short summary is to be enclosed (i.e. figure 1: site plan, figure 2: atrium, etc.). One of the illustrations must be identified as the main picture and must be marked with an 'H' and the respective number (i.e. H6).
- A short explanation is permitted for each submitted project (maximum of 1,600 characters).
- 'Application and registration form' is to be filled out typewritten and submitted with the award documentation (digital copy available at www.bda-hamburg.de).
- Each submitted document must be furnished with an abbreviation of the building and the name of the architect(s). The separate image files are excluded from this.
- Offices with a partner under 35 years of age, (until 26th April 2018), can claim a deduction on the fee. For evidence a copy of any personal identity card, stating the date of birth, has to be submitted.

Assessment criteria

The documents to be submitted should allow assessment based on the following criteria:

integration into the urban surroundings; architecture and design; appropriateness concerning the task; contribution to the development of construction; and compatibility with the environment.

Prizes and prize-giving

- There are three prize categories for architects and construction partners for the entire project:

Category 1: BDA Hamburg Architecture Prize 2018.

Three prizes usually awarded at the same time.

Category 2

Category 3

- The number of projects in the 2nd and 3rd categories is determined by the jury.
- Furthermore, the jury will name projects that will be included in the official presentation and documented in the catalogue.
- Architects and construction partners who are placed in the 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize categories receive a certificate as a prize. Furthermore, their projects are presented in an official presentation and in a catalogue together with the additional projects chosen by the jury. Prize money is not awarded.
- The prizes will be awarded during a celebratory prize-giving ceremony.

Presentation and the documentation in the catalogue

- The projects chosen by the jury are publicly presented and published in a catalogue.
- Through their participation in the prize, participants agree to the presentation of their projects and to their documentation in the catalogue as well as to other publications on the basis of a decision by the jury without any remuneration and make image and text material necessary for this available to BDA Hamburg free of charge and free of third party rights. Any parties involved in the design (i.e. employees, landscape architects, specialist engineers etc.), as well as photographers, will be identified by name for copyright reasons.

Costs

1. Participation fee:

- BDA members as well as offices, with a partner under 35 years of age, must pay a participation fee of € 250.00 excl. 19 % VAT (total € 297.50) for each submitted project.
- Non-members of the BDA must pay a participation fee of € 500.00 excl. 19% VAT (total € 595.00) for each submitted project.
- The participation fee must enter the BDA account number 43 03 616 at the HypoVereinsbank Hamburg (Sort code 200 300 00; IBAN DE22 2003 0000 0004 3036 16; BIC HYVEDEMM300) by the deadline of 26th April 2018 with the comment of 'Architecture Prize 2018'.
- If payment of the participation fee is not made on time, the submitted projects are not eligible for the prize.

2. Presentation and catalogue fee:

- Participation in the presentation and catalogue is obligatory for projects in the 1st to 3rd prize categories, as well as all additional projects chosen by the jury. A further fee is to be paid for the presentation and the catalogue.
- BDA members as well as offices, with a partner under 35 years of age, pay a fee of € 250,00 excl. 19 % VAT (total € 297.50) for each submitted and awarded project. Non-members of the BDA pay a fee of € 500.00 excl. 19 % VAT (total € 595.00).
- A request for payment is made with the announcement of the results of the prize jury.

The prize-giver cannot assume any liability for any damage to or loss of submitted documents.

Declaration of consent

All participants declare their agreement with the content and provisions of the award through their participation in the award.

- Sending of the requested documents by post by Thursday 26th April 2018 (postal stamp date)
- Projects submitted at a later date are not eligible.
